

**Minutes of IMODS Meeting
June 19, 2008**

In attendance: Al Curtis, Randy Miles, Bill Novello, Sonya Baysinger, Fran Roehm, Scott Holtz, Louis Irmo, Susan Irmo, and Kathy Skobel

President Miles called the meeting to order at 6:35pm.

President's Report: Mr. Miles described progress on the Back Lot Bash and reminded members that volunteers were needed along with money to fund the silent movies at the Skokie Theater. IMODS currently has pledges for \$3,000 of the \$5,000 needed.

The recent car show has proved to be successful. One more sponsor is needed to complete funding for the event. The next show is scheduled for July 16.

Niles West will be holding its 50th anniversary reunion on October 4. Tickets are \$75 including dinner and a show.

Mr. Miles requested that IMODS pay \$250 to fund the appraiser for the upcoming Antique Road Show. The request was unanimously approved.

Finally, IMODS is waiting for approval by the Village Art Advisory Board to install the Baur sculptures in the lot next to Veterans' Park.

Arts Committee: Ms. Baysinger advised that the Baur artwork will be on display through July 31. The next exhibit, starting on August 9, will be Yellow Brick Road. An Arts Forum is scheduled to be held at the Library on June 24 at 7:30pm. The Skokie Sculpture Park will be celebrating its 20th anniversary on June 28.

Al Curtis provided an update on activities at Skokie Theater including the fact that WGN radio will be broadcasting from the theater on July 11 from 9-11am.

Mr. Novello presented the prior meeting minutes and current financial statements which were approved.

Scott Holtz presented a brief update on web site activity.

All business being completed, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:20pm.
